A special thanks to Hannah Dougherty Campbell, Class of 1969 for finding the original drawing of our school seal on ebay (left). The seal along with the envelope address to Rev. Burns, the first principal of the school, was placed on ebay for sale. The Alumnae Association purchased the seal and will be framing it and placing it at the school. It was offered for sale by an auction house who found it in a box of papers purchased at an auction in Lancaster, PA. It is a mystery who had it and how it got out of the school.

We also found another West "antique" on ebay, a 1936 HOW AND WHAT Conduct Book. This appears to be a handbook for new students on how to find their way around the building and also what was expected of them as a student.
