In Memoriam

The Alumnae Board sadly lost a longtime board member and past President in May when **Helen Sheridan** passed away. The following tribute to Helen was written by Sr. Ave Armstrong, SSJ, a dear friend of Helen's.

Helen Sheridan was a gentle, intelligent teacher at West Catholic High School for over two decades. A graduate of St. Callistus Elementary school and West Girls', Helen returned to her Alma Mater and taught history in both West Girls' and the combined school. This professional woman taught on Chestnut Street for three decades then moved on to Bishop Shanahan before retiring from the classroom. Helen kept her connection with West Catholic by faithfully serving on the Board for a number of years. In her professional demeanor, Helen always projected to her students a warm and positive presence. In addition to her academic commitments, Helen recognized her social responsibilities also.

Initially, she monitored the school newspaper, *The Reaper*, as a service to West. Also, this dedicated history teacher served as the department head for many years and initiated the World Affairs Club in order to introduce her students to a wider scope of traditions and cultures. Likewise, Helen trained future lawyers in the Mock Trial Club and loved deepening the students' perspective by taking them on various field trips. A world traveler, this cosmopolitan history teacher visited China, Australia, New Zealand, many European countries, and had a real love of Ireland, the land of her parents' birth. As a member of the faculty, Helen offered support and guidance not only to her students but also to new teachers. The students taught by Helen Sheridan experienced a wise and wonderful Catholic woman, and she will be remembered by her students and peers in this light.

Joan O'Connor Mullarkey, Class of 1959, fondly remembers her time attending American Bandstand shows while a 9th grade student at St. Barnabas/West Catholic annex. She took the 36 bus to 49th & Woodland and got on the bus to Bandstand at 46th & Market Sts.

Joan remembers the show beginning at 3:30 and ending at 4:30. The nuns at West discouraged students from attending Bandstand. Nevertheless, rascal Joan put a sweater over her uniform and sat in a corner by Dick Clark's stand so the nuns watching tv in their convents wouldn't see her. She once was selected to rate a record and the jitterbug and cha-cha were her favorite dances. Girls fast danced with girls back then and Joan was always willing to dance a slow dance when asked by the guys. She went to Bandstand 2-3 times a week and stood in line with regular dancers and first-time dancers. Joan knew the infamous Justine and Bob and Little Ro. Bob Horn was the co-host for a while and Joan spoke with Dick Clark many times and said he was very pleasant. Her favorite guest singers were Paul Anka, Dion, Jerry Lee Lewis and many others. Joan remembers being on camera among the usual 50 dancers and her family was watching the show from home. Joan met a lot of friends from various areas of the city and said it was an experience, a place to go, that she'll never forget.

Father Zaleski celebrated the Mass at St. Charles Borromeo Church in Drexel Hill, PA. The Mass was attended by Mr. Collistra, Mrs. Lanza, Mr. Brady, the 2 Assistant Principal, Mr. Jazz Williams and Mr. Michael Field, and 2 students representing the class.

The graduation was filmed from the Cathedral. The presenters and speakers, Archbishop Perez, Bishop Fitzgerald, Paul, Kelly, Jazz and Michael were filmed in advance and then spliced together for the virtual ceremony. There were also remarks from the Valedictorian, Anna Nguyen and the Salutatorian, Julia Tran. As each of the 100 student's name was called their graduation picture was shown on the screen. It ended with the Student Council President, Javon Hitson flipping the tassel on his cap.

This class continued in the path of the previous classes with 100% being accepted to college with more the \$24,000,000 in scholarship dollars. The students were accepted by 389 colleges and universities and are attending 55 of the schools. 6 graduates elected to attend trade school or enlist in the armed services.
